On day 3, he becomes confused, agitated, febrile, and reports visual hallucinations.</p> <p>Identify the stages and type of alcohol withdrawal seen in this patient and outline the pharmacological management for respective stages.</p>
2	<p>A 32-year-old man dependent on heroin presents to you 24 hours after last use. Outline the opioid withdrawal symptoms expected in this patient, and describe the pharmacological management strategies.</p>
3	<p>Differentiate between cannabis intoxication and withdrawal in terms of clinical features and outline the management approach for both conditions.</p>
4	<p>A 42-year-old man attempting smoking cessation reports irritability and craving within a day of stopping tobacco.</p> <p>Describe the timeline and symptoms of nicotine withdrawal, and outline the pharmacological and non-pharmacological management options.</p>
5	<p>Describe the non-pharmacological principles of disposition and follow-up common to substance withdrawal management.</p>
