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To prepare the granules and compress the tablet of given paracetamol drug

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Requirements:-

- Chemicals:- Pure paracetamol drug sample, starch, Magnesium stearate, Talc.
- 2) Apparatus:- Mortar Pestle, Beaker, stirrer, Sieves.

 Instruments:- Weighing Hot Air Oven, Water Bath, Tablet Punching Machin(KBR Press).

Objectives

Granulation:

- •To convert fine powders of paracetamol into free-flowing granules.
- •To ensure uniform distribution of paracetamol and excipients.

Compression:

- •To compress the prepared granules into tablets.
- •To achieve tablets with desired hardness, friability, and disintegration time

Formulation Table

Procedure

1) Weighing and Mixing:

- •Weigh the required amount of paracetamol and excipients.
- •Mix paracetamol with the filler in a mortar and pestle or mixer.

2)Granulation:

- Prepare the binder solution (e.g., Starch in water).
- •Add the binder solution to the powder mixture to form a wet mass.
- •Pass the wet mass through a sieve to form granules 20.
- •Dry the granules in an oven at a suitable temperature (e.g., 60-70°C).
- •Once dried, Take a weight of dried granules.
- pass the granules through a sieve 22/44to break up any lumps.
- •Calculate the 10% fines of total wt of the granules and add into dried granules

3)Lubrication:

•Mix the dried granules with lubricants and Glidant to ensure smooth tablet compression.

4) Compression:

- Set up the tablet press.
- Adjust the machine settings to achieve the desired tablet weight, thickness, and hardness.
- Compress the granules into tablets.

5) Evaluation:

- •Test the tablets for hardness, friability, and disintegration time.
- •Ensure the tablets meet the specified quality parameters.

6)Packaging:

 Once the tablets pass all quality tests, they can be packaged for storage or distribution.
